

## GENERAL RULES FOR THE OMAHA CYCLING WEEKEND

This official race announcement is a guideline highlighting special technical regulations for the Omaha Cycling Weekend Nebraska State Championships RR and TT. All events will be in accordance with the USA Cycling 2012 Rulebook.

PRE-REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED FOR THE TIME TRIAL AND ROAD RACE. On-line registration will close at 6:00pm Central time Friday night for the Road Race and Saturday night at 9:00 PM Central for the TT. Go to <http://www.usacycling.org> to register online. If you cannot register online with a credit card, you may mail or deliver an application along with a signed USAC waiver and payment to:

Mailed applications for the road race must be received by 5pm on **June 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2012**. Be sure to submit a separate application for each race. The Time Trial is online registration only. See: <http://geckotechit.com/GreenStreets.htm>

Applicants must pick up their packets and sign a USAC waiver on-site prior to each race. Race organizers are not responsible for long lines or delays associated with check-in. Please allow sufficient time prior to your race to pick up your packet.

In the event of low rider turnout, the organizers reserve the right to cancel/combine events and prize lists as necessary or to award prizes to only the top half of each category.

Junior gear restrictions will be strictly enforced (as specified in the USAC 2012 Rulebook). All junior riders will be subject to a rollout immediately following their competition.

Race result protests must be filed within fifteen minutes of a result posting. Race incident reports must be filed with a race official within fifteen minutes of the finish of a race. Race organizers will make every attempt to distribute prizes the day of the race within an hour of posting final results. In the event a rider does not claim a prize within one month of the event, the prize will be forfeited.

All races will begin promptly as scheduled and will be conducted regardless of weather conditions, unless the officials and race organizers agree to modify and/or cancel a race due to extraordinary circumstances or potentially dangerous weather or road conditions.

Number placement will be on the left side for the Road Race and on the right side for the TT. Please note that the specified location is subject to change the day of the event. Please verify number location when picking up your race packet prior to each event.

Points will be awarded at all events for the **Nebraska Rider of the Year (ROY) series** except for the Master's Categories in the Road Race. There is no Masters category for the TT. The Nebraska Cycling Association is responsible for calculating points after the conclusion of the weekend. ROY points will not be calculated by the organizers during the event. ### **RACE SUPPORT**

No personal or team support vehicles will be permitted in the Time Trial or Road Race. Neutral wheel support may be provided in the road race on a "wheels in, wheels out" basis. Wheels should be clearly marked with rider name and race number if neutral support is provided. All riders must submit wheels to the drop off site at least 15 minutes prior to the start of the first race. During the road race, a rider should pull off to the right side of the road to receive service. Wheels should be reclaimed within 30 minutes of the conclusion of each race.

### **ROAD RACE MASTERS GROUPS**

There will be separate categories for Masters 40+, 50+ and 60+ but they will race together. 50+ is eligible for 40+ payouts; 60+ is eligible for 40+ and 50A+ payouts.

## REGISTRATION OPTIONS:

1. ONLINE: <http://www.usacycling.org> and register online. It is fast, secure and the preferred method of registration by the race organization. Online registration closes at 6:00pm, Saturday, July 16, 2011.
2. MAIL: Registration may be mailed to Craig Tuttle, 14922 Hanover Street, Bennington, NE 68007. Mail registrations must be received no later than 5:00pm on June 22, 2012. .
3. **NO DAY OF REGISTRATION:** In order to avoid start list and officiating confusion, the organizers have decided to discontinue day-of registration.
  - Entry fee includes USAC \$3.00 surcharge. An estimated online registration fee of \$2.70 will also be applied.
  - Riders must have USAC annual license OR purchase 1-day license.
  - 1-day licenses will be available for purchase on-line for \$10.00.

## GENERAL RACE RULES & INFORMATION

- All 2012 USAC rules are in effect.
- Events will be held rain or shine.
- Place race numbers on the appropriate side of jersey as directed at check-in.
- Helmets must be worn at all times while on the bike.
- Valid and current USAC license must be presented at rider check-in.
- All riders must present a current Nebraska driver's license or equivalent to be eligible for Nebraska State Championship awards.
- Race organizers reserve the right to cancel/combine events or pay out to only the top half of a field in the event of low rider turnout.
- Held under USAC Permit 2012-2305 .
- Neutral wheel support will be "wheels in/wheels out." Please make sure to identify your wheels properly. Promoter is not responsible for lost or stolen wheels.
- Yellow line rule will be vigorously applied. The RR course will open to two full lanes in the last half mile leading up to the finish line.

## DIRECTIONS

From Omaha: I-80 West to Hwy 50 (144<sup>th</sup> St) south to Hwy 66 (the bridge is under repair and down to one lane). Turn west/right at Hwy 66 (follow signs for Platte River State Park). Turn north into park and right at entrance booth. Proceed to Fox Hollow area or past that to the restaurant for parking.

From Lincoln: I-80 east to the South Bend exit. Go east on Hwy 66 through South Bend to Platte River State Park. Follow note above once entering the park.

## FACILITIES AND PARKING: PLATTE RIVER STATE PARK

Due to the rural areas around the course, parking will be available near the Fox Hollow area at Platte River State Park. There is a \$5 daily permit required. Registration will also be at Fox Hollow—look for the check-in tables and tents. The entrance to Platte River State Park is on Highway 66 just west of Hwy 50.

## **COURSE DETAILS**

Each race group will stage at the exit of Platte River State Park on Hwy 66 and proceed neutral to the intersection of Hwy 66 and 334<sup>th</sup> St. The race will start just south of this intersection. The finish will be on the hill at the north end of 310<sup>th</sup> St. From the start just south of Hwy 66 on 334<sup>th</sup> St, racers will proceed down 334<sup>th</sup> St south to Church Rd. The course turns west onto Church Rd. to 310<sup>th</sup> St. Racers will turn north onto 310<sup>th</sup> St. and right up to Hwy 66. The course proceeds east on Hwy 66 back to turning south on 334<sup>th</sup> St. This loop is approximately 10 miles completely around. Again, **the finish line will be near the top turn on 310<sup>th</sup> St.** This will be an uphill finishing sprint. After finishing, riders should quickly move off the road surface to allow following groups of racers who have not finished to continue their race. The finish line tent will be on the west side of the road. After you have finished your race, you can stay at the finish line to support other racers on the course or ride back safely to the entrance to Platte River State Park. Prizes and awards will be distributed in the parking lot at the registration area at Fox Hollow in Platte River State Park.

There will be one official feed zone at the first hill crest below the finish line on 310<sup>th</sup> St.. Hand-ups will be from the right hand side of the road only. Neutral water will be provided and personal or team hand-ups are also allowed within the feed stop area only. Hand ups outside the official feed zone are not permitted.

**Course:**

The race starts ¼ mile south of Yutan High School staging area. The course consists of a 24 mile out and back route starting/finishing next to Veteran's Country Club. The route winds south on Yutan Road towards Ashland. The road surface is in good condition, has minimal traffic, but is open to traffic. Law enforcement will be aware of the race and course marshalls will be stationed along the course for rider safety.

**Background:**

The Nebraska State Time Trial crowns the fastest rider in the Great State of Nebraska yearly. Win your category and take home this esteemed crown. Break it out anytime your riding pals start talking trash to you about how fast they are. So Fabians, walk the walk and enter the Race of Truth.

We changed the start day to Sunday to accommodate the Omaha Cycling Weekend and to minimize traffic.

Register online at [USA Cycling registration for NE State TT Championships](#). Online registration opens May 24th and closes Saturday, June 23rd, at 9 PM CST. There will be no day-of, onsite registration. Race will be held rain or shine, unless severe weather is apparent.

Only Nebraska residents are eligible for the State crowns, but the race is open to all out-of-state racers too. You must have a USAC annual or a one-day (\$10.00) license to race. The license can be purchased here: [USA Cycling license purchase](#). Sleeveless jerseys are acceptable. Helmets required.

Triathletes are welcome to race. If you have a USAT (triathlon) license and you don't have a USAC (bike racing) license, we will deduct \$5.00 off of your entry fee. Present your license at registration to receive your refund.

Junior gear restrictions will be strictly enforced (as specified in the USAC 2012 Rulebook). All junior riders will be subject to a rollout immediately following their competition.

**Schedule:**

Start times being at 9 AM promptly. We will have a official race clock. Be at the start line 5 minutes before your start time. Don't be late! Your time starts as scheduled whether you are at the start line or not. Racers are slotted by time in reverse-order of their registration, so register early to start the latest. Then you will have all the rabbits in front of you to pick off, one by one.

Other prizes: Nebraska State Championship medals (gold/silver/bronze) awarded to top 3 finishers in each category.

Top Masters finisher in 40-49 age group and 50-59 age group will receive \$25 if not placing in top three of their category.

Remember, **NO DAY OF REGISTRATION**. Don't call me, don't email me if you miss the deadline. Don't show up to race if you haven't registered online. This will enable us to score the event without post-race confusion. Entry fee covers USAC \$3.00 surcharge and AMB Chip Timing rental. No refunds will be issued under any circumstances.

**General Race Rules:**

- All 2012 rules are in effect
- Event held rain or shine
- Place race numbers on the right side of jersey
- Approved helmets must be worn at all times while on your bike
- Valid and current USAC license must be presented at race check-in, which starts at 800 AM
- Held under USA Permit 2012-1403
- Race organizers reserve the right to cancel/combine events or pay out to only the top half of a field in the event of low rider turnout.
